



INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS - 2022

All subcontractors are required to furnish a Certificate of Insurance (COI) showing compliance with the insurance requirements set forth in Exhibit G of the Subcontract. Certificates can be submitted during Subcontractor Onboarding or via email to nyinsurance@hitt-gc.com.

- Additional Insured Completed Operations (CG2037 04/13 or equivalent)
- Waiver of Subrogation
- Primary/Non-contributory
- Designated project aggregate limit endorsement

Automobile:

- Additional Insured
- Waiver of Subrogation

Umbrella Liability:

- Follow form Additional Insured Ongoing Operations
- Follow form Additional Insured Completed Operations
- Follow form Waiver of Subrogation
- Follow form Primary/Non-contributory

Workers' Compensation:

- Waiver of Subrogation (where permitted by law)

Additional requirements:

- Hazardous activities: Pollution Liability
- Design activities: Professional Liability
- Projects in New York: Complete Acord Form 855 NY

Notes:

- All Subcontractors are required to have active and valid workers' compensation insurance while on any Americon HITT jobsites, no exceptions.
- Product completed operations coverage is required to be maintained for minimum five (5) years post-completion
- Insurance requirements also apply to lower-tier subcontractors
